Hammered beaten by mob

He then grabbed a Bic blue regular and penned the immortal words: "The body's membership will consist of at least a simple majority of students from any of its regular active meeting membership."

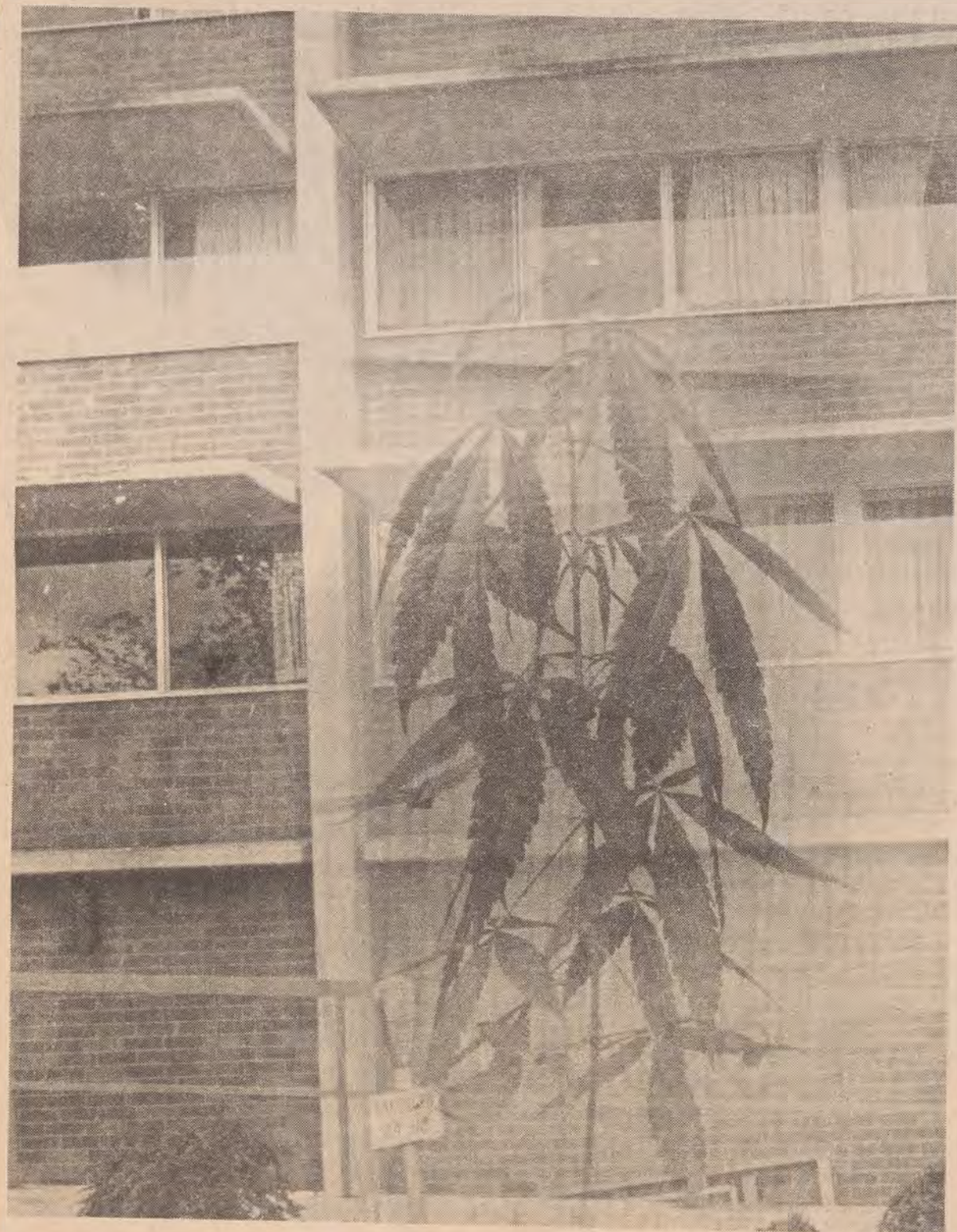

ANUS Senate doesn't make decisions, sense

The ANUS Senate met Wednesday for 17 hours and approved absolutely nothing.

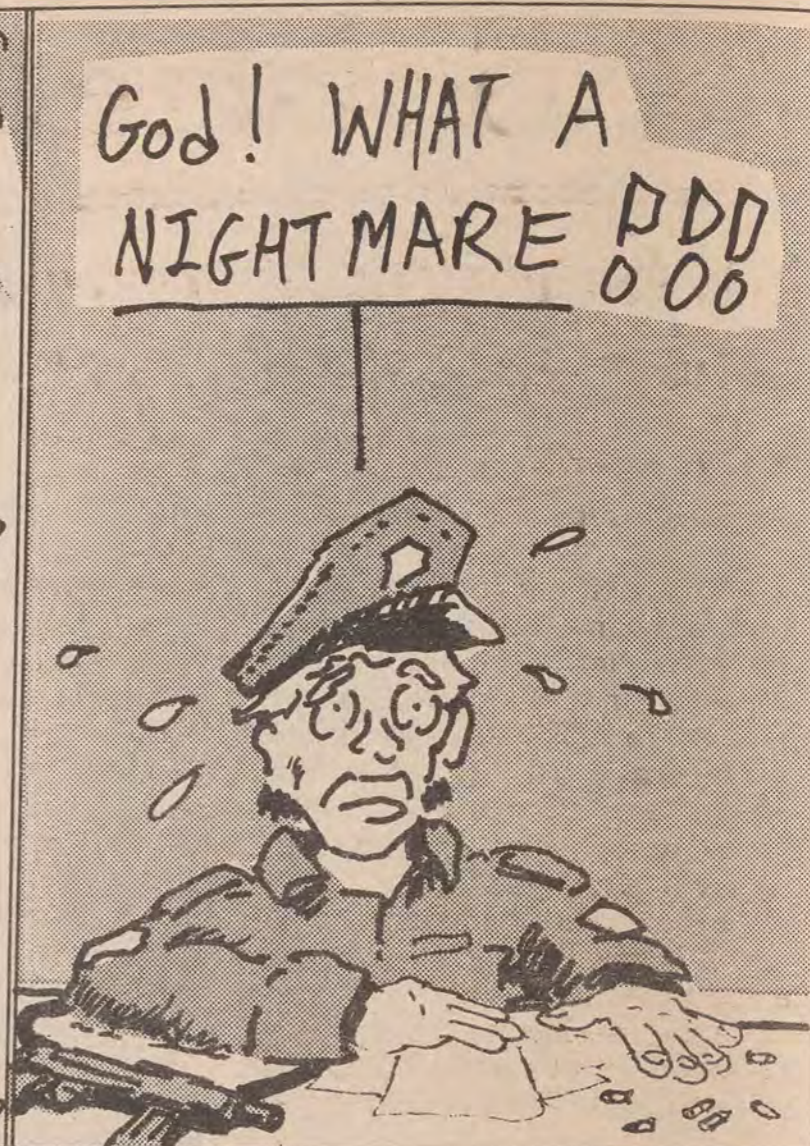

UNR sports served sunny side up

1985-86 was a stupid year — as usual — for UNR athletics.

Not to be outdone by Curtis Bligh's delightful cameo role in the television mini-series, "Well, the White Girl Asked for It, Didn't She?" the UNR athletic department continued on its merry way full of bad, cheap sex, unrestrained violence and overall mayhem.

If UNR athletics ever became a television show, not even ABC would pick it up for a six-week trial run.

The "lowlights" were many this year.
